International and National Journals Journal Policy and Ethics

The International and National Journals published by Sathyabama University Press aims to contribute to the advancement and dissemination of knowledge and technology in various the fields of Engineering Sciences and technology. The Press accepts papers that are original work of the authors and not published or submitted for publication elsewhere. The time frame for publication of the manuscript form the day of submission is 3 months. Submission to first decision: 2 weeks; Time for revision: 4 weeks; Time from acceptance to online publication: 4 weeks.

Editorial policy

Manuscripts submitted to Sathyabama University Press must represent original research work that it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere in any other language or any other journal. The language of submission is English. The submission for publication must be approved by all authors.

Authorship

The Press recommends that authorship should be given for significant and substantial contributions to the experimental analysis / design of the research work; for the analysis and interpretation of data; for drafting and revising the article. Authors should ensure and report only original work and that the experimental work is carried out accurately and should not be misleading. The corresponding author should inform all the authors about the status of the manuscript throughout the review and publication process. Any change in authorship after the first submission requires an agreement signed by all authors.

Conflict of interest

Authors are requested at the time of submission to disclose any arrangements which might be a concern for conflict of interest in connection with their submitted worksuch as commercial association/consultation undertaking, equity/stock ownerships, patent-licensing, etc.If the research reported is sponsored or funded, then the funding source for the project must be credited in the Acknowledgments section.

Use of human subjects or animals in research

Manuscripts reporting experiments on human subjects should clearly state in the article that the research is complies with the Helsinki Declaration of 1964, and with the ethical standards of the responsible committee on human experimentation (institutional and national) and should state the name of the committee that approved the work. Experiments using animals should be conducted in accordance with the relevant institutional and national standards; authors are required to indicate whether the guidelines for the care and use of laboratory animals were followed.

Data set

Authors making use of various data sets in their manuscripts should clearly produce declaration about the source of the collected data sets. The images or movies used in research should be of high quality and high resolution. The Press welcomes certified images or movies.

Journal Correction Policy

The Press will take necessary action if violation of the ethics related to publication is observed. A written statement should be sent to the Editor-in-Chief, if any corrections are to be made in the article which has already been published in the Journals released by Sathyabama University Press. Corrections will be incorporated only if a small portion of the article is flawed in a way and it does not severely affect findings reported in the article.

Violation of Journal Ethics

The Press considers the following as violating the Journals Ethics and may lead to the denial of publication of the article or its retraction from Journal. The following violations are considered as Plagiarism by Sathyabama University Press.

• Article text is copied from other articles and claiming it as own.

- Self-plagiarism: coping substantial parts of his/her own published work without providing appropriate references.
- Results of the study are manipulated such as by drawing graphs, graphs and pictures STOLEN from other articles, unreliable findings
- Using copyrighted figures without permission from the author/journal
